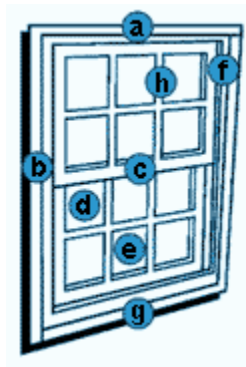


These are the Components of a Window



- a. The **head** refers to the upper boundary of the window and represents to top of the entire window.
- b. The **Jamb** comes from the French for leg and supports the outer edge of the window (the left and right boundaries).
- c. The **frame** refers to the entire outer portion of the window and the construct in which the sashes or other parts move.
- d. **Glazing** is any process or material applied to a pane of glass.
- e. **Panes** are individual units of glass, divided by mutton bars.
- f. A **sash** is an entire assembly of panes and is the part that generally moves.
- g. The **sill** is the lower portion of the window, which usually protrudes out from the wall.
- h. **Muntin** bars separate individual panes (also known as grilles or windowpane dividers)
